

The Sheridan County Library seeks a creative librarian to provide learning fun for children ages 0 to 5 and library coverage on an as-needed basis.

- Do you love to learn?
- Are you outgoing and want to connect with children and their caregivers?
- Do you enjoy a flexible work environment?

If you said, “Yes!” to these questions then this might be the opportunity you are seeking.

Must-have qualities & skills:

- Responsibility. You must be able to work independently to create and deliver weekly library Story Time programs for children ages 0-5 September through May and Summer Reading activities June and July.
- *Demonstrated ability* to create and present children’s programming.
- Technically savvy. Be prepared to assist patrons with a variety of technical questions that can arise during day to day hours. This includes, but is not limited to, assisting users with printing, copying, the public internet access computers, troubleshooting the occasional smart device, navigating the library catalog and assisting with library related apps and software.
- Creative, positive, outgoing.
- Love of learning, especially about library related resources and services in order to assist the public with their information needs.
- Love of books and reading, especially children’s books.
- Must love interacting with kids and their caregivers.

Qualifications: You could have acquired the skills and abilities for this position through a combination of education and experience. Maybe you have experience in teaching, day-care, pre-school, or babysitting. Or maybe you just really want to work with children and their caregivers in a library setting and are willing to learn everything you can about children’s programming.

Preferred Qualification: Experience with teaching and/or previous experience working with children.

What will be required?

- Weekly family Story Times: Plan and deliver weekly children’s Story Times for ages 0-5 from September through May.
- Summer children’s programming: Prepare and market summer reading activities and programming for June and July.
- Library coverage on an as-needed/limited basis primarily when additional staff support in the library is needed.

This is a part-time (12-15 hours/week position). Starting wage: \$15.00/hr. The Sheridan County Library encourages applications from all persons regardless of race, religion, sex, age, national origin, or disability.

How to apply: Please submit a Sheridan County employment application. Be sure to include any experience interacting/working with children, programming ideas you have, and any qualities and skills that support why you want to work at the Library.
